There are separate hunting areas for ages 3 & under, ages 4-6, & ages 7-12. Parents are only not allowed to enter the areas for ages 4-6 & 7-12 but there are ample viewing areas located along the sidelines. Vehicle entry to the Park is \$8 (cash only) for a 1-day permit.

#### **Get ahead of Hay Fever**

A seasonal allergy (hay fever) is an allergic reaction to a trigger to a pollen allergy that is typically only present for part of a year, such as spring or fall, which include trees, weeds and grasses. Perennial allergies are usually present year-round and include allergens such as pet dander & house dust mites. Molds can be seasonal or a perennial allergy trigger. Animal dander is 1 of the biggest allergic triggers,

whether your it's your pet or not. The most common problem is the allergy to the animal's dander, hair, saliva & urine, especially since the hair and dander are present in large amounts in the air, indoors & out, which settles on furniture & on the carpeting. Dust mites are microscopic creatures that live in our bedding, pillows & mattresses & they eat human dead skin flakes & synthetic materials. The biggest source of indoor mold is the outdoor air in humid climates and moisture in kitchens & bath.

Here are some recommendations to cut down on the amount of allergens present in the home:

- Vacuum carpet and floors frequently and use a vacuum cleaner equipped with a HEPA filter
- Purchasing a HEPA air filter for the bedroom
- Steam clean carpet & furniture, launder drapes
- Wash bed linens in hot sudsy water weekly and bedspread & pillows monthly
- Encase mattress in plastic covering
- Use a de-humidifier to decrease mold growth and use a bleach solution to clean & kill mold
- Empty garbage can daily to deter cockroaches
- Frequent clean counters & floors, seal food
- Keep pets outside or if indoors, off the furniture, out of the bedroom and ask someone else to wash your pet once a week
