IN CASE OF FIRE

Get out of building first, then call 911 and management office. Close doors behind you as you escape. Before opening door, test doorknob and spaces around the door with the back of your hand. If door is warm, do not open and try another escape route. If door is cool, open slowly and close door behind you to keep out smoke. In case of smoke, crawl keeping your head 1-2 feet above the floor where the air is the cleanest.

Fire Safety Tips The best way to stop a fire is to never let one start and since fire prevention is all of our responsibility, we invite you to join us in identifying fire hazards and safe objects in your home. Watch for more info to come next month.

Fire Escape Plan Develop a fire-escape plan. You should know at least 2 ways out of every room in your home to safely escape a fire. Hold fire drills regularly. Pick a meeting place outside of building in case of fire. Once outside, stay out! Call 911 from mobile cell phone outside of the building.

Smoke alarms Understand the need for working smoke alarms. Test it once a month and change battery once a year.
