

# About the Emergency Housing Voucher Program

The Emergency Housing Voucher Program is a special voucher program established as part of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA). Funding for this pandemic-era program has not been extended and the program will end on June 30, 2026.

Please note: This update only applies to the Emergency Housing Voucher Program. Other HADC Housing Choice Voucher programs are not impacted by these changes.
